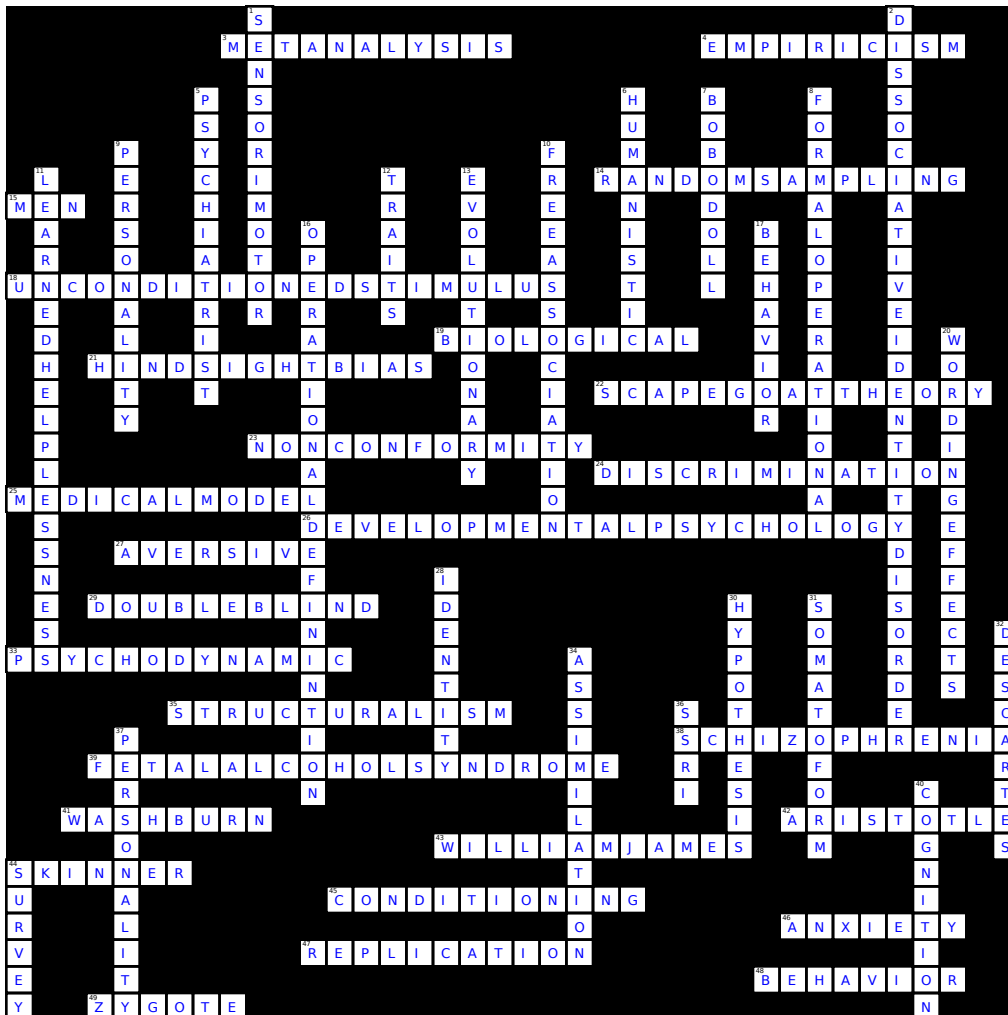

- A procedure for statistically combining the results of many different research studies
 - View that knowledge originates in experience
 - A group in an experiment that fairly represents a population because each member has an equal chance of inclusion
 - Critics of Kohlberg's theory of moral development argue that the stage of post conventional morality is more characteristic of which sex?
 - In classical conditioning, the natural spur that causes a reaction
 - This perspective focuses on how the body and brain enable emotions, memories, and sensory experiences
 - People's tendency to exaggerate their ability to have foreseen the outcome of past events
 - The idea that prejudice offers an outlet to place blame
 - If a culture believes in individualism, they most likely also believe in what?
 - The learned ability to distinguish between a conditioned stimulus and other irrelevant stimuli
 - This psychological approach calls mental illnesses sickness
 - The study of physical, mental, and social changes that occur throughout the lifecycle
 - Conditioning is used in Behavioral Therapy
 - When researchers and participants in a study are unaware of which group they are in, this is called:
 - This approach examines how behavior springs from unconscious drives and conflicts
 - This was an early school of psychology that used introspection to examine the human mind.
 - This group of disorders is characterized by disorganized thinking, disturbed perceptions, and inappropriate emotions or actions
 - Physical and Psychological abnormalities in children caused by pregnant women's heavy drinking
 - This woman was the first to receive a PhD after Harvard declined to give it to Mary Calkins
 - First philosopher to theorize that knowledge is not preexisting, but rather grows from experiences
 - This American psychologist was a prominent functionalist
 - This scientist created the operant chamber to study the effects of operant conditioning
 - The process of learning associations
 - This type of disorder is characterized by apprehension and fearfulness
 - Researchers do this to studies in order to prove that their results were in fact correct
 - In the mid 20th Century, psychology moved away from studying mental construct and moved toward observing this:

- This stage of Piaget's occurs in infants who interpret the world mainly in the form of impression and motor activities
 - When people exhibit multiple personalities that operate separate from one another
 - This type of specialist can prescribe medication and went to medical school
 - This personality perspective emphasizes the importance of our capacity for healthy growth and self love
 - Bandura's experiment with this toy showed the power of observational learning
 - This developmental stage is characterized by an ability to think logically about hypothetical situations
 - An individual's characteristic pattern of thinking, feeling, and acting
 - This method of study encourages exploration of the unconscious
 - Passive resignation to unavoidable stimuli
 - Characteristic patterns of behavior and conscious motives are called what?
 - This perspective focuses on how natural selection of traits promoted survival of certain genes
 - A defined interpretation of variables in an experiment
 - This type of therapy is designed to changing the way people act
 - Findings in a survey can vary based on the way a question is phrased. This is known as what?
 - Erikson says that adolescence is all about discovering what?
 - This is a testable prediction that helps research focus and find direction
 - This group of disorders is classified by physical pain with no discernible physical cause
 - This man's theories about the mind and the body being distinct led him to theorize about how they communicate
 - Interpreting concepts in terms of current understandings (schemas)
 - This group of drugs partially blocks the uptake of serotonin
 - This group of disorders are described as inflexible and enduring behavior patterns that impact social functioning in a negative way
 - Piaget studies how children develop their abilities to think, know and remember, known as:
 - A technique for ascertaining the self reported attitudes or behaviors of a group of people.
