Please obtain the following supplies:

- 1-1 Subject Spiral Notebook to be dedicated to this class **OR** a devoted and clearly labeled section filled with looseleaf in a binder. (No composition notebooks they get too messy and pages fall out). Students must have this even if planning to use Ipad for notes. The notebook or binder will sometimes be mandated, especially in lab. It will also be our source of looseleaf paper for small quizzes or assignments to be handed in during class.
- 2 At least 3 decent quality folders for just this class. No, you may not use the folder that comes in the spiral notebooks because the pockets barely hold anything. If you choose to have a binder for notetaking, you can get folders that have holes so you can store them in the binder.
- 3-*Pens*, *pencils* in class every day. Pencils should be used for hw problems and exams unless told otherwise. Pencils are also used exclusively in the lab.
- 4 A scientific calculator of some kind. Don't buy one you should already have one from Math class. Graphing calculator is acceptable since we don't take a Regents exam, where they are prohibited. This is needed for class EVERY day.
- 5 TOTALLY OPTIONAL but might be helpful a mini-stapler so you can quickly staple things, highlighter, red pen for correcting work, colored pencils for graphing, small metric ruler. I would also suggest that you have a good stylus so you can "write" your homework neatly on your Ipad as is often required. You need access to colored pencils and a ruler from time to time, but not regularly, and you will get notice.

Homework due on Wednesday 9/12:

- Label your notebook on the front cover with your name and APSH or have the section of a binder clearly labeled for APSH.
- Label ALL of your 3 folders on the front covers, neatly with your full name and APSH. On one of the 3 folders, please also write GRADED LABS, and on a second folder, please write the words EXAMS and QUIZZES. On a third folder, please also write INUSE. 2 of the 3 folders can stay home in a SAFE place, to be discussed in class.
- Make sure all labels are neat and that they are permanent. Sticky labels are good if you can make sure they will stick. Maybe share a pack of labels among friends.
- Items 1, 2, 3, and 4 from the materials list above must be present and will be checked on Wednesday, 9/12.

***Proper neat labeling is part of this HW grade. If the items are not labeled, the HW is NOT DONE!
