There are some areas that need work, but overall, the project has a rhythm to it.</p> | <p>Enter Title</p> <p>Project flows very well. The ideas presented are clear, concise, and have a logical progression and flow.</p> |
| Creativity | <p>Poor</p> <p>The project showed very little creativity.</p> | <p>Fair</p> <p>The project is somewhat creative, but is not very original and did not take a great deal of thought.</p> | <p>Good</p> <p>The project is creative and has good ideas. Some new and better ideas could have been used.</p> | <p>Enter Title</p> <p>Ideas are original and unique. The student obviously thought his/her ideas through and made a good effort at creating something unique.</p> |
| Sentences | <p>Poor</p> <p>Sentences are improperly structured and make little or no sense.</p> | <p>Fair</p> <p>Sentences are understandable, but several structural issues still exist, including subject verb agreement, word placement, accents, and punctuation.</p> | <p>Good</p> <p>Sentences are understandable and though a few errors exist, the student demonstrated an understanding of Spanish sentence structure.</p> | <p>Enter Title</p> <p>The sentences are structured very well and a mastery of Spanish language structure is clear.</p> |
