

# What to do on a CRQ

## Remember :

- ★ Prove what you learned in class
- ★ If you cannot show that you learned something in class, you will not be able to earn full credit on that particular question.
- ★ Your answer **SHOULDN'T** come directly from the document. Instead, you should be able to take some information from the document and combine it with what you learned about that topic in class.
- ★ REMEMBER THAT DETAILS EARN YOU CREDIT. If you are vague in your answer, you should expect that you will not earn credit.

## Answer using ACE:

- Answer the question that has been given to you by restating the question.
- Cite text or information directly from the document
- Explain with Evidence to link the cited evidence to something that you learned



## Document 1

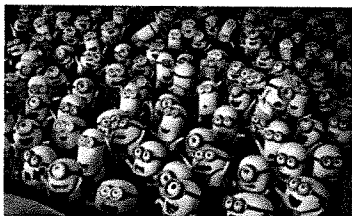
- ★ Question 1 will always be a **historical circumstances/context** OR **geographic circumstances/context**
  - THIS MEANS BACKGROUND
  - When you are completing this question, you need to ask yourself **HAVE I PROVIDED BACKGROUND TO THIS DOCUMENT THAT IS NOT LISTED IN THIS DOCUMENT?**

## POINT of VIEW

### Document 2

Questions 2 will be either

- ★ **Point of View**
  - what is the attitude towards what the author is speaking about?
- ★ **Audience**
  - who was this document created for?
- ★ **Purpose**
  - why or what reason was this created at the time it was written?

### Questions 3a and 3b-

- ★ Identify and Explain a **Cause & Effect** relationship associated between Documents 1 and 2.
  - The historical (event/idea/development) in the source ... was a cause of the historical (event/idea/development) in source ...
- OR**
- ★ Identify and Explain a **Turning Point** associated with both Documents 1 and 2
  - The first source relates to \_\_\_\_\_ because ... Furthermore, the second source is related to \_\_\_\_\_ because...
- OR**
- ★ Identify and Explain a **Similarity or Difference** between Documents 1 and 2
  - The similarity in Document 1 is evident by ... because... Furthermore, the similarity in Document 2 is evident by... because...
