This letter outlines our programs at the end of the Summer for SFP Follies and iPad distribution and set-up. We have organized these days to help students to get to know the school, their fellow classmates, and productive use of the iPad. We will instruct students about many practical skills to help make their time at St. Francis Prep meaningful, enjoyable, and productive. We look forward to working with you to make for a great beginning of your high school years. The schedule for these required days is below.

MONDAY, 30 AUGUST: SFP Follies: 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

We will start with prayer in the Auditorium. Students will then report to their COR (homeroom). They will meet with their Cor teacher and senior peer counselors; there will be time for the students to get to know each other. There will be a tour of the school and a field events and games program. This day is for <u>students only</u>. Students may want to bring a water bottle and wear sneakers. - These orientation days mark the official beginning of your time as a student at St. Francis Prep and a member of our community. We expect to see all students on these days.
- Students should wear comfortable clothes these days; students should not be in uniform.
