

Retreat Leader Application

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Retreat Leader for the 10th Grade Retreat Program. Please read this application carefully. All requirements must be fulfilled to be considered for this important leadership role.

Requirements

Students applying to be a Retreat Leader must:

- be a 10th or 11th grader with a passing average. Seniors will be given preference when equally qualified, but are not entitled to the position.
- receive a favorable review by the Religious Education Department.
- be willing to discuss your faith openly and lead prayer services.
- not have a history of *chronic detentions or absences*. All names are submitted to the Deans' of Students Office for review.
- answer questions on application. Quality, not quantity, is important in answering these questions. Please write legibly, typing is preferred.
- be willing to attend an interview scheduled during a free period, before or after school.
- attend the required training sessions.
- participate in an overnight retreat (Fall date: Thursday, Oct. 3rd- Friday, Oct. 4th)
- act appropriately as a role model for younger students during your time at St. Francis Preparatory.

Expectations

Retreat Leaders are expected to:

- act as if you are a Retreat Leader every day!
- attend after or before school meetings to prepare for your assigned retreat.
- read the monitors, check your e-mail, Google Classroom and the bulletin board outside the Campus Ministry Office for announcements.
- know the date of your retreat and be fully prepared for your parts.
- inform your teachers about when you will be out of class two weeks ahead of time. The sooner the better!!!
- be enthused, as if your day is the one chance you have. Be creative!
- be available to serve as a support person for sophomores after your retreat day is finished.
- take time to pray...especially before your retreat day.
