Revolutions in Europe and Latin America (1790–1848)



📕 TEXT SUMMARY

At the Congress of Vienna in 1815, European leaders tried to return Europe to the way it had been before the French Revolution. (See Chapter 19.) These leaders were part of a group known as **conservatives.** Conservatives included monarchs, noble landowners, and church leaders. Conservatives wanted to return the kings of Europe to power and restore historic social classes. Conservative ideas also appealed to peasants who wanted to preserve traditional ways.

Liberals disagreed with the ideas of the conservatives. Liberals included members of the middle class. Many of their ideas came from the Enlightenment. Liberals wanted governments to be based on written constitutions. They believed that

people had natural rights. Disagreements between conservatives and liberals led to 30 years of turmoil in Europe.

Another challenge to the conservatives came from the **nationalists.** They believed that each national group should have its own country. For centuries, European rulers had won and lost territory in war. They passed lands back and

forth, from one country to another. By 1815, several European empires included people of many different nationalities. Nationalists wanted to create their own homelands. During the 1800s, nationalist groups across Europe revolted against the empires.



THE **BIG** IDEA

Conflicts arose in Europe between people with opposing systems of thought and belief.
